The Multimedia Production concentration requires 31 hours of Major and 18 hours of Cognate coursework. A student may apply for entrance into this selective program during his/her sophomore year. ACCEPTANCE INTO THE PROGRAM IS LIMITED and based on an applicant's admission to the Multimedia Institute, which includes (but is not limited to) the following criteria: (1) performance in previous production courses; (2) evaluation by previous Media faculty; (3) previous class attendance, participation and academic performance; (4) the student's entrance essay and interview; (5) the student's professional goals; (6) and, a willingness to commit to the discipline and schedule of the program. Students not selected to the Multimedia Institute will be required to choose a different Media concentration or major. Students who transfer into ORU or who declare this area of concentration after 32 credit hours of college coursework may be required to spend additional semesters to complete the program.
