Students who have completed Health Fitness I and Health Fitness II undergraduate at ORU shall meet the requirement by completing two or more activity courses that total 1.0 to 1.5 credit hours.

\*\*\* Degree Plan must be approved by the student's advisor, the Graduate Chair, and the Dean immediately after full acceptance into a graduate program. Students are responsible for meeting with their advisors to be sure all 36 hours of graduate requirements are completed.
