# YOU ARE CONFIRMED!

For ORU's Spring College Weekend April 2-4, 2009



You are confirmed for Spring College Weekend, April 2-4, 2009. The following pages will provide you with important information that you need to know upon arrival.

#### ARRIVAL

Your first stop on campus will be in the South Lobby of the Mabee Center. This is where check-in takes place. Once you check-in you will receive your College Weekend packet, housing assignment, and meal card. Checkin is on Thursday from 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

#### SHUTTLES

Shuttles to and from the Tulsa International Airport or the downtown bus station will be available upon request, Thursday-Saturday. You must provide us with your arrival time and flight/bus number by calling 1.800.678.8876 (ext. 3) or 918.495.6165 or by emailing the information to campusvisits@oru.edu. Once we receive your arrival information, we will have an ORU van waiting for you outside, between the two baggage claim areas by the bronze statue. Be sure to fly into Tulsa International Airport (TUL).

#### LINENS

If you did not bring your own linens, the College Weekend department has a **limited** number of linens that can be checked out from the College Weekend Information Center in the Fireside room. A deposit of \$20 cash or a valid driver's license is required to ensure the return of these items.

#### PARENT CONNECTION

Parents are encouraged to attend all sessions, in particular:

- Parents' Reception—Thursday evening
- Parent/Sponsor Luncheon—Friday
- Parents' Breakfast—Saturday morning

All Parent events are free of charge. Parents and family members who accompany guests to College Weekend have the option to purchase a \$25 meal pass available at registration that covers meals for the entire weekend (two meals on Thursday, three meals on Friday and one meal on Saturday).

#### APPLICATIONS

Get your \$35 admissions application fee waived by submitting your application during College Weekend and turning it in at the Information Desk in the Fireside room.

#### UNIVERSITY BOOKSTORE

Be sure to take full advantage of the ORU University Bookstore discount, which you will receive during the weekend. Items such as souvenirs, music, books, clothing, and additional ORU merchandise may be purchased. Hours are 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Friday, and 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Saturday. The bookstore is located on the third floor of the Learning Resources Center (LRC) across from the glass enclosed stairs.

#### CURFEW

The College Weekend curfew varies according to the day but will be no later than midnight. Curfew will be enforced by your College Weekend group director. The parents of any guests who do not check in with their College Weekend group director (*dorm guests only*) will be called at 12:45 a.m. by the College Weekend Coordinator. Not adhering to curfew is grounds for dismissal from College Weekend.

#### LOST AND FOUND

We suggest that students coordinate with their host/hostess to keep their rooms locked during their stay. ORU is not responsible for the loss of personal property or money. Any articles lost or found during your stay should be reported to the College Weekend Information Center. Check out will begin on Saturday after our closing session at 1:00 p.m. in the Fireside room. Students requiring transportation should report to the transportation desk two hours prior to their departure time. We request that all students make arrangements to depart on Saturday, April 4 by 5:00 p.m. Any late departures must be cleared with the Campus Visitation department by calling 800.678.8876 (ext. 3).




