## Articulation Agreement Between Oral Roberts University and Florida Christian University February 2023-June 2026

Oral Roberts University (ORU) and Florida Christian University (FCU) share a similar mission of preparing students to reach their world with the Gospel of Jesus Christ and to demonstrate God's healing power through the Holy Spirit. Therefore, the two institutions hereby enter into the following articulation agreement which will commence on February 2023.

## Goals of the articulation agreement:

- 1. A seamless transition process that allows students from FCU to transfer to ORU and receive the maximum allowable credit towards a baccalaureate degree.
- 2. Clear guidelines and degree plans that enable FCU students to effectively plan their transition from FCU to ORU and gain the maximum allowable credit.
- 3. Effective means of communication to raise awareness among FCU students of the opportunities available through this articulation agreement.

## Provisions governing the agreement:

- 1. FCU students must meet ORU's minimum academic and admissions requirements in order to be considered for admission to ORU.
- 2. Under the current course matrix, FCU offers 23 classes that are eligible for transfer to ORU.
- 3. A total of 30 semester hours including the senior paper/project, must be taken at ORU.
- 4. All ORU general education requirements must be fulfilled in a student's degree plan.
- 5. Only courses with a grade of "C" or better will transfer. Remedial and developmental courses will not transfer.
- 6. Representatives from ORU and FCU will periodically update transfer and admission policies, ensure that appropriate information is readily available to FCU students, and work together to develop mutually beneficial arrangements between the two institutions.
- 7. Course transfers will be reviewed and evaluated based on the ORU Course and Instructor Qualification Policies and Guidelines.
- 8. Through ORU's prior learning assessment process, adult learners may receive up to 30 hours of credit for knowledge gained through non-college courses, on-the-job training, or personal studies. This is in addition to the articulated courses transferring from FCU.
