

HOW TO READ YOUR TRANSFER EVALUATION REGISTRAR'S OFFICE (918) 495-6549

ORU accepts transfer hours for course work earned at accredited CHEA recognized institutions (no remedial/developmental or orientation courses accepted). Only courses in which a grade of "C" or better is earned can be considered for transfer. The GPA from another institution will not be transferred to ORU, only the credit hours. A course that transferred in as an elective, but that might meet major, concentration, cognate, minor or general education requirements, may be petitioned for approval from the department chair in which a course is offered at ORU to be accepted for an equivalent ORU course.

TRANSFERRABLE COURSES

ORU title & number: recorded for courses accepted as equivalent to ORU courses

ELEC 999: a course that transferred in as an elective, but might fulfill a requirement if approved by the department

chair in which the course is offered at ORU. The Petition for Transfer Course is available online at

petitions.oru.edu. A copy of the course description/syllabus must be uploaded in the petition.

transfer passing with course credit (Covid-19 pandemic terms, AP & CLEP) TPC:

NON-TRANSFERRABLE COURSES

NTD: non-transferred course -- "D" grade

NTF: non-transferred course -- "F" grade (also applies to AP & CLEP scores below level to receive credit)

NTI: non-transferred course -- "incomplete" grade

NTIP: non-transferred course -- in progress, changes to transferrable if applicable after final transcript is received

NTP: non-transferred course -- "pass" grade (allowed for transfer credit during Covid-19 Spr. or Sum. 2020)

NTR: non-transferred course -- remedial, developmental, vocational or orientation

non-transferred course -- "satisfactory" grade NTS:

NTW: non-transferred course -- "withdrawn" grade

NT(a): non-transferred course -- "audit" grade

non-transferred course -- missing grade (course is on transcript but without an assigned grade) NTM:

non-transferred course -- unaccredited school NTU:

NTG: non-transferred course -- no equivalent grade at ORU

non-transferred course -- excessive hours NTX:

NT*: non-transferred course -- repeated course
