GRADUATE QUEST FELLOWS AND SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Oral Roberts University seeks to educate students who exemplify a whole person lifestyle as they pursue excellence intellectually, emotionally, spiritually and physically.

Scholarship Awards will range from \$1,000 to \$5,000:

Scholarships are applied annually and are good toward full-time enrollment in a master's or doctoral level program.

The Dean's Fellow Awards – Each graduate school has one Dean's Fellow. The Fellowship Award covers 100% tuition and includes a \$15,000 annual stipend. Fellows duties will be assigned by the respective dean. New Fellowships will be offered as vacancies arise.

Scholarship Competition Guidelines:

1. New students admitted to an ORU graduate program for the fall semester, and current ORU graduate students who have completed twelve or fewer hours of graduate study in their program of interest at any institution (including ORU), are eligible to apply. At the discretion of the graduate school, current students who are recipients of the Graduate Quest Scholarship may be invited to be considered for open Fellows positions.
2. Applicants must submit a resumé or curriculum vitae organized into the following categories:
 - I. Intellectually Alert
 - II. Physically Disciplined
 - III. Spiritually Alive
 - IV. Socially Adept
 - V. Professionally Competent
3. Applicants must also submit an essay, two to three typewritten pages, on a topic selected by the graduate school. Specific essay topics can be found online at quest.oru.edu/gradessay.
4. Students who complete a qualified application may be invited to participate in an interview, which will be conducted on the ORU campus or via an online video conference.
5. Students are encouraged to submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to ORU as early as possible.
6. Scholarship award notifications will be mailed on or before April 25.

Recipients of the Graduate Quest Fellows and Scholarship Program awards will be selected by the Scholarship Review Committee, the ORU provost and the deans of ORU's graduate schools. The scholarship will be renewable for up to three years, toward full-time enrollment in a graduate program at the University. Recipients' awards will be reviewed annually. Renewal of an award is contingent upon having satisfactorily fulfilled the requirements of the award, including maintaining a cumulative GPA of 3.0 and remaining in good standing with the university.
